And, just like that, another Church year has passed! Welcome to the Season of Advent/Christmas – the beginning of the year on the Christian calendar!

As we look at the last month of 2022, probably the most important announcement I need to share is that your Session – after much thought, discussion and prayer – has decided to have our annual Christmas Eve Service on Saturday, December 24th. The service will begin with music at 8:30PM and the Worship Service will begin at 9:00PM. However, the Session also voted to NOT have Church only a few hours later on Christmas morning. It was decided that this was asking a lot of your worship leaders, musicians and tech crew. Instead, you will be offered TWO different virtual opportunities. The first will be a recorded worship service recorded by several Presbyterian Churches here in the "Findlay area." Your Choir and I will be involved. You will also be offered a recorded Worship Service provided by Churches from all over the Synod of the Covenant (all of Michigan & Ohio). You will be free to enjoy these two worship experiences as much or as little as you wish, and links to the videos will be provided soon.

Speaking of the Findlay Area Churches video, we need TEN (10) volunteers from our congregation to appear in a very short video clip for this. We want you to give a ONE WORD answer to the question: "what is your favorite Christmas gift EVER?" I will be seeking you out in the first few days of December, as the video needs to be submitted by December 11th so it can be edited, etc.

Also, the Education Committee has decided there will NOT be Sunday School on either Christmas Day (we won't be here) or the following week on New Year's Day (because we hope you'll want to spend time with your family and watch some football).

As the clock ticks ever so steadily toward the end of 2022 and the beginning of 2023, I pray that you will be able to rest in God's loving grace, and that your days will be filled with the love of family and friends. I wish you all a VERY HAPPY Christmas and a bright and healthy New Year.

Elder Victim Ministry, a program of Crime Victim Services

So far in 2022, Crime Victim Services has helped 33 people who had credit accounts opened in their names, or credit cards stolen or misused. With identity thefts growing by the day, it's important to monitor your credit report. On Credit Check Wednesday, Nov. 30, 2022, five local financial institutions will coordinate with Crime Victim Services to offer credit report checks in 18 locations.

After some of our largest spending days, Black Friday, Small Business Saturday, Cyber Monday and Giving Tuesday, stop in Wednesday, Nov. 30 to review your credit report at: Citizens National Bank: Bluffton, Elida and Lima branches. West St., Delphos, Ottawa and Wapakoneta branches. TopMark: N. West St. Lima, Allentown Rd. Lima and Cridersville branches.
