Session will meet Sunday, June 18 after worship.




## **Presbytery Report**

Our Presbytery gathered in Bowling Green on May 16. Much of the business was a follow-up to paperwork from last summer's General Assembly meeting. To summarize, all of the proposed changes to the Book of Order have received enough votes from the PCUSA presbyteries to be approved. To some this may seem like a lot of "red tape;" however, we need to celebrate that we can peaceably look at issues and continue to move ahead even if we don't always agree. For more active news, a PDA trip to Kentucky is being planned for October 7-14. Cost is roughly \$200/person. Positions are still available. We know how helpful those PDA (Presbyterian Disaster Assistance) volunteers were here in Ottawa. This can be an opportunity to return the service, so consider signing up. And you can wear those wonderful blue T-shirts again!!
