The month of June has brought changes at Ottawa PC, as well as some new activities at the church. The following are highlights from Session over the last month:

Session voted to terminate the contract with Lance Wiesmann after serving our church since early April 2021. His service has been valuable through this transition time, but also with the expressed desire of our congregation from the very beginning to move towards a called pastor, the action of terminating his contract would have been the end result at some point regardless of timing, and so session felt that this was an appropriate time to do so. With that, they ask for your patience and understanding as we now work with a selection of pulpit supply pastors during this new phase of pastoral search.

The PNC since being elected in February has been meeting each week, and has moved through the preliminary but necessary steps towards seeking a new call for Ottawa. This has involved working extensively on a document for the Church Leadership Connection which is ultimately the way in which churches are matched with potential candidates seeking a new call. After a brief scare through the suggestion that we had to start fresh on a new document, we were able to submit this finalized and approved document to Louisville CLC and now have been issued our first batch of candidates to review. Please include our committee in your prayers as they start to evaluate and reduce the list of matched candidates to a handful that they might take further steps in contacting through interviews, reference checks, and sermon videos.

Thursdays have brought a lot of activity to the church with our "Presbyterian Potty" community service event, in allowing the public to utilize our church bathroom during the Cultural Committee concerts on Thursday evenings at the Rex Center. This has brought many new faces into our church, and has included requests to tour the sanctuary and questions about our congregation. We also are wrapping up the Happy Campers vacation bible school put together by several of the young people in our congregation. It was a great success and brought some outside children into our church in a casual but fun and educational setting.

We hope to have you attend church on July 16th as we hold another Congregational Conversation where we will discuss some strategic future items well as the financial implications of pursuing a full time pastor. This will be informative to Session, the PNC, and yourself as a member of the Congregation!!
