Finding a Sunday driver is difficult indeed. I have:

- * placed a Help Wanted Ad in The Courier
- * contacted the agency who employs Steve (K&P Transport via Find-A-Ride)
- * contacted both the Hancock County and Putnam County Agencies on Aging as well as some private individuals. The fact is that 'Sunday drivers' are just very scarce and hard to find! But my church and church family mean everything to me and I'm not giving up hope! If anyone has any suggestions or is willing to help, please let me know!
