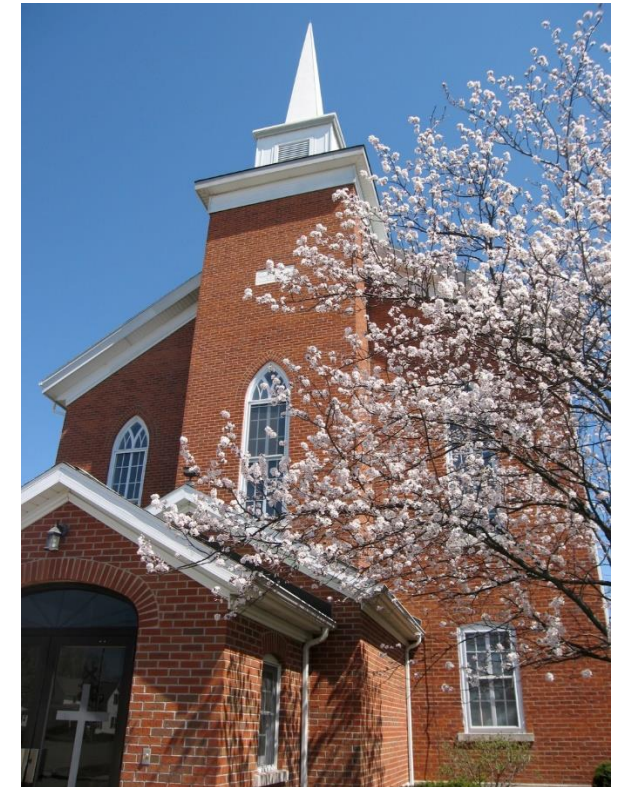

Introduction to John & Nancy Shuffle

John & Nancy have been involved in both solo and leadership positions in music ministry throughout much of the United States as well as Internationally, featuring a specific interest and mandate for conveying the rich and biblically accurate portrayal from both Testaments of our Hebrew LORD, “GOD with us,” Yeshua (Jesus), in His proper First Century context through both songs and related teaching.

Their combined concert travels over the last 25 years in particular have taken them to 38 States and 6 foreign countries, which have included numerous special benevolence concert appearances for tens of thousands of pilgrim believers visiting in Jerusalem and elsewhere in Israel on behalf of the International Christian Embassy – in response to the prophetically important Biblical mandate found in the Book of Isaiah ...“Comfort ye, comfort ye, My people.” Truly, believers in Yeshua have been grafted into a larger, inclusive Body (Romans 11), with all of its attendant privileges and mandates!

Though they often bring a classically accented approach to their ministry concert vocalism as a direct result of their formal training and

backgrounds, John and Nancy typically present with a large variety of musical styles in their worship repertoire. Their individual resumes also include some 170 combined total major roles performed in primarily the Opera, Oratorio and Musical Theater genres. They have also recorded several different, representative music ministry repertoire CD projects which they always have available at their ministry concerts.
