Church Movie Night: Sunday, March 24 at 6:30 pm. Will be watching "Jesus Revolution". Popcorn and soda provided. All are welcome.

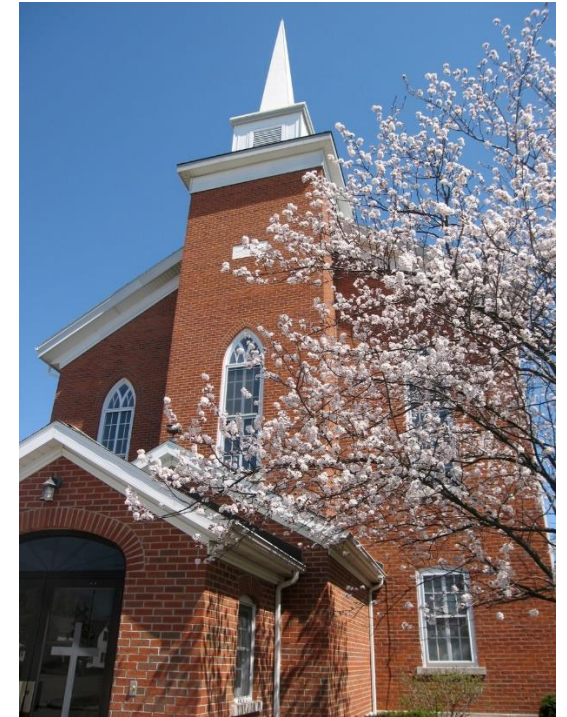
