Rex PPP will be this Thursday, June 13, from 5 – 8:15 pm. (More cont. on back...)

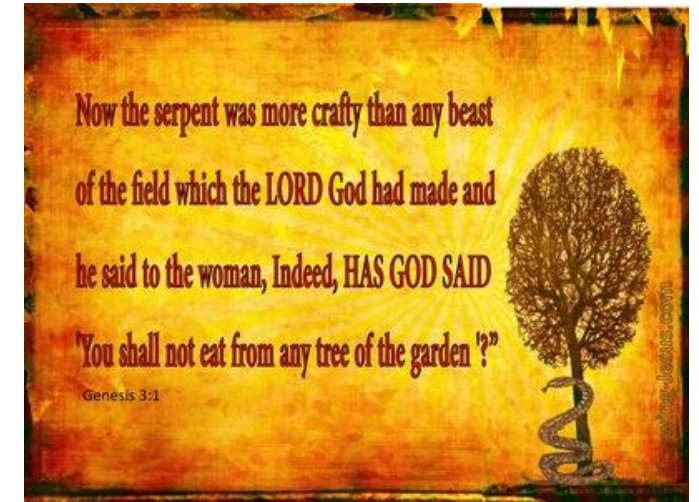
