Beloved Ottawa Presbyterian Church community,

We are in the middle of Lent and are preparing our hearts for Easter 2025. While we may anxiously await the glorious news of Jesus' resurrection, let us not hurry. May we continue over the next several weeks our focus on prayer, our abstention from those things that detract from our relationship with God, and our sharing of alms with those in need. Let us continue to reflect on our relationship with God and discern what is next in our lives – both as individuals and as a congregation searching yet again for a long-term pastor.

As I said at the beginning of March, while this season of repentance and now transition is understandably difficult, it is important to honor the calling that God places on our lives, for God is always with us, guiding our next steps, and encouraging us to grow in whatever way God sees necessary. Remember how God told Joshua when he took on new leadership of the Israelites, “Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go.” Speaking for myself alone, I am not afraid during this season of growth and stretching; and I am not discouraged by the sudden uprooting of my home, my husband's growth in his workplace, my children and their educational journey, or my ministerial roles. Rather, I am choosing to focus on God's intentions for this time, and in wonder and awe, I ask God: “God, what are you teaching me now? How am I growing in this? How is my family growing and stretching? Most importantly, how are we honoring and serving you?”

Therefore, I encourage you, friends, during this season of repentance and transition: “Be not afraid; be not discouraged, for God is with you always, wherever you may go.” Embrace your life in Christ and this next chapter in this congregation with open hearts and minds and lean into God's calling in YOUR life. Particularly in this season of Lent and as we approach Easter, remember with courage and good cheer that nothing can hold God back; and nothing will hold you back when you place your trust in God.

Let me close with some practical information. Before my departure at the start of May, you have plenty of time to chat with me about your grief as well as questions and concerns. **Please reach out any time!** I know this can be extremely hard for many of us! Also, mark your calendars (May 4) for a congregational meeting and conversation following worship. This will be an important meeting and conversation with many pastoral updates. Please plan to attend!


