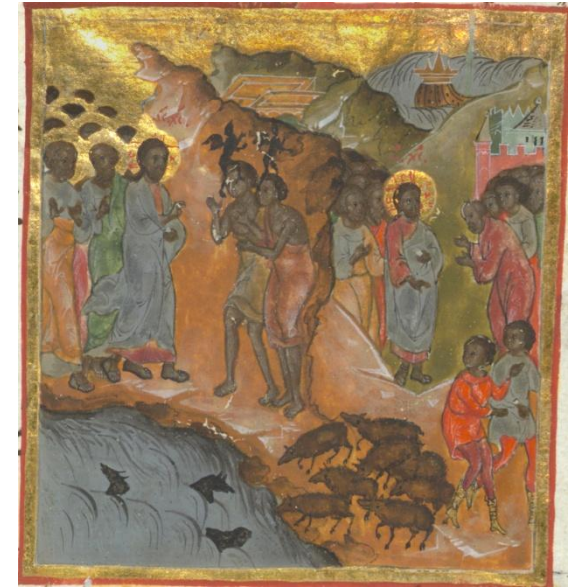

RESPONSE

*Affirmation of Faith

All: The Holy Spirit unifies the Christian Church. The diversity in the early church caused tension and conflict. Yet the Spirit bound them into one body, enriched by their differences.
