My duties as a session member are to oversee the church building upkeep and its use.

This church was built in 1867, 2 years after the Civil War ended. Hopefully, some of our youth will be present in 2067 for the 200th anniversary of this building.

We currently provide office space for Habitat for Humanity as one of our mission endeavors. Did you know that back in 1980s and 90s we had Head Start classes housed in our church? Before we built the classroom addition in 1988, we had to hold all Sunday School classes in fellowship hall, using dividers on caster wheels to separate the classes. Back in the 1800s, our fellowship hall was referred as the "Sabbath School Room." The steeple was added to the church in 1967, after a severe storm in the spring damaged the original bell tower. Because of your dedication to this building and God's work on the corner of 3rd and Oak Street, it is one of the oldest churches in NW Ohio and has served many souls through the decades.

May God continue to bless our building and its people for many more decades!
